DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE AND HOST HOTEL:

From East: on RT 78 or RT 76 (PA Turnpike) - to I-81S/Carlisle and merge onto I-81S. Take exit 52 for US-11 toward I-76/New Kingstown/Middlesex. Go .2 miles, keep left at the fork, follow signs for US-11 and merge onto US-11N/Harrisburg Pike. Hotel will be on the right.

From West: I-81N - Take exit 52A to merge onto US-11N/Harrisburg Pike toward New Kingstown. Hotel will be on the right.

CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.
DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **DOGS NOT REQUIRED** for further judging will be excused.
JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The Show-giving club and the Show Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.
ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.
CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Show Secretary to be advised at once. The Super-intendent and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.
THE SHOW COMMITTEE/SHOW SECRETARY will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.
