Directions: 16.4 miles (about 21 mins), N29 W23950 Schuett Dr., Pewaukee, WI 53072. Turn RT on Hwy 67 for 1.6 miles to Hwy 94. Take ramp towards Milwaukee. Ramp will be on RT. Merge onto Hwy 94 E for 12.2 miles to exit number 294 (county highway 164 / J). (landmarks are Comfort Suites Hotel/M&I Bank/Machine Shed Restaurant). Turn LT (north) on 164/J/Pewaukee Rd for 1.7 miles. Turn RT (east) onto Schuett Drive. PVS is the first driveway on the LT.

Directions: 15.4 miles (about 20 mins), 360 Bluemound Rd., Waukesha, WI 53188. Turn RT on Hwy 67 for 1.6 miles to Hwy 94. Take ramp towards Milwaukee. Ramp will be on RT. Merge onto Hwy 94 E for 12.2 miles to exit number 294 (county highway 164 / J). Turn RT (south) on highway J and proceed to Bluemound Road (highway JJ). Turn LT (east) onto Bluemound Road. WVRC is the first driveway on the LT.

AIRPORTS

O'Hare in Chicago is about 2-2.5 hours away from the Show Site. Renting a car or being picked up by a friend is an option to then get to the hotel.

General Mitchell Airport in Milwaukee is located on the southeast side of Milwaukee. It is about ¾ to 1 hour way from the hotel. You can rent a car, do GO Airport Connection or be picked up by a friend to get to the hotel.

Madison Airport is about 1 hour from the hotel. Renting a car or being picked up by a friend is an option. GO Airport Connection is also possible.

HOTEL RULES

- Owners / Agents are expected to clean up after the dogs.
- Grooming room available after 6 pm on Monday for setup only-no electricity available until Tuesday.
- Hotel guests will be expected to sign Room & Dog Agreement forms upon checking into hotel; www.esaernational.com.
- Look for dog friendly entrance-not through the main lobby.
- A \$75.00 refundable/\$25.00 Non-refundable* deposit per room is required at check in from guests with dogs in rooms (total deposit \$100.00).
- Anyone parking on the grass, golf course or along the road will be ticketed or towed.
- Housekeeping **must clean** rooms daily (hotel policy). Anyone refusing service will be charged \$25 each day.
- A maximum of five (5) dogs will be permitted in each resort room.
- All dogs must be crated at all times when left unattended in guest rooms; Plastic required under all crates
- NO Bathing or Grooming dogs in rooms.

ROUTES TO SHOW

FROM EAST: Take 94 out of Milwaukee heading West. Go about 32 miles or 35 minutes to exit 282 North. This is Highway 67. Go about 1.5 miles to Regent Rd, Turn Left onto it. Turn Left at stop sign. This is Olympia parking lot.

FROM WEST: Take 94 out of Madison heading East. Go about 50 miles or 55 minutes. Exit 252 North or Left onto Highway 67. Go about 2 miles, turn Left onto Regent Rd, Left at stop sign. This leads into Olympia's parking lot.

FROM SOUTHEAST: Out of Chicago/O'Hare take 94/294 North. Take either 94 through Milwaukee downtown or 894 around the South end of Milwaukee. You'll pick up 94 West to Madison on the West side on Milwaukee. Go about 32 miles or 30 minutes to exit 282 North. This is Highway 67 North. Go about 1.5 miles to Regent Rd, Turn Left. At stop sign, Turn Left. This is Olympia's parking lot.

FROM SOUTHWEST: Take 90/94 out of Rockford/Beloit. At Madison, Turn East onto 94 to Milwaukee. Go about 50 miles or 55 minutes to exit 282. Go North on to Highway 67. Go about 2 miles. Turn Left onto Regent Rd. At stop sign, Turn Left. This is the parking lot for Olympia.

FROM THE NORTH: Take 94, 39, 41 or 43 from whichever side of the state you are. 94 to Madison, you will follow the directions from the West. From 39, you will merge with 94 and follow the directions from the West. From 41 or 42, you will merge with 94 to follow the direction from the East.
