DIRECTIONS TO GREAT LAKES PET EMERGENCIES:

1221 Tittabawasee, Saginaw, MI 989-752-1960. I-75 N to Exit 155. South on I-675 to Exit 6 (Tittabawasee Road), Right about 1/4 mile on right side.

"Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment."

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule printed in this program. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged. The show-giving Club and Superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. Being an unbenched show, you need to be at show only in time for your judging and may leave any time after judging. Numbers before each Breed represent the number of dogs entered in (1) the regular dog classes; (2) regular bitch classes; (3) Specials Only, Best of Breed or Best of Variety Competition; and in (4) Non-Regular classes.

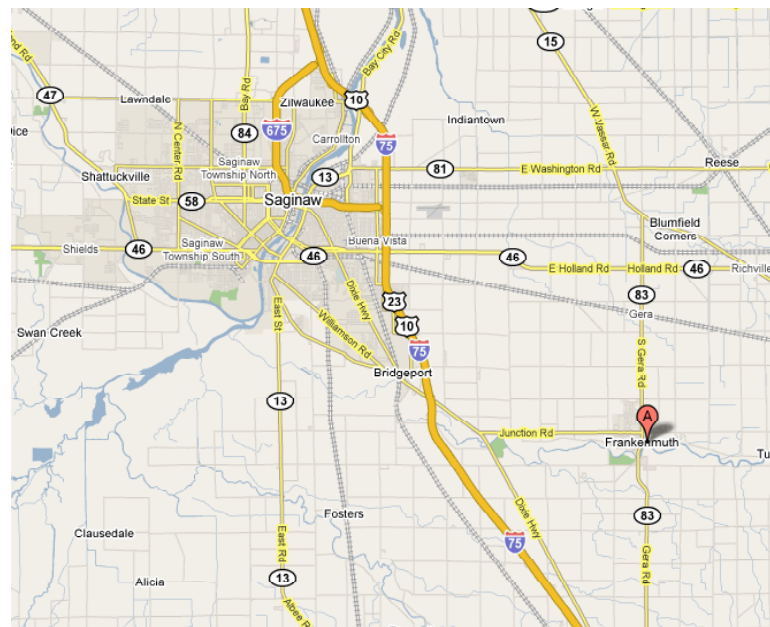

ADDITIONAL SHOW RULES

The Newfoundland Club of America, Inc. may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or any other cause, in accordance with AKC rules and regulations. No one shall have any claim or recourse against the Newfoundland Club of America, Inc. or any official thereof.

NO DOG SHALL BE ELIGIBLE to compete at any show, no dog shall be brought into the grounds or premises of any dog show and any dog which may have been brought into the grounds/ premises of a dog show shall immediately be removed if it:

- a. Shows clinical symptoms of distemper, infectious hepatitis, leptospirosis or other communicable disease or
- b. Is known to have been in contact with distemper, infectious hepatitis, leptospirosis or other communicable disease or
- c. Has been kenneled within 30 days prior to the opening of the show on premises on which there existed distemper, infectious hepatitis, leptospirosis or other communicable disease.

THERE IS NO SPACE provided for unentered dogs.

EXHIBITORS ALONE ARE RESPONSIBLE for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be subject to Bench Show Hearing and be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

NO SMOKING is allowed under any show/grooming tent where the dog show is conducted. This is by order of the Frankenmuth Fire Department.

THE CITY OF FRANKENMUTH prides itself in having handicapped accessible Parking, Restrooms and Ramps throughout the City. Our hotel has handicapped accessible rooms. Restrooms at show site are handicapped accessible.

STATE LAWS regarding Handicapped Parking areas will be strictly enforced. Please observe these laws and do not park in these areas unless your vehicle is so designated.

Handicap Rooms available in Hotel, Information packet has request form for those with special needs.

THE CLUBS, their members, Executive Boards, the Superintendent, their agents and employees and the Bavarian Inn Lodge will not be liable for any loss, damage or injury which may be sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians.

PLEASE REMEMBER TO TURN OFF CELL PHONES AND/OR PAGERS BEFORE ENTERING RINGS.

Admission and Parking is FREE for Spectators.

Use of Flex Leads during show hours is prohibited.

No Grooming (bathing-trimming-powdering etc.) of any dog will be permitted in hotel guest rooms. Violations will be reported to the Event Committee. All hotel sites are under the jurisdiction of the Event Committee.

Dog Washing Stations with warm water for bathing will be provided outside on the show grounds.

The Kern Pavilion (grooming building) will be open 6:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. Dogs may NOT be left in the Kern Pavilion or any other grooming area overnight. There will be NO security personnel on duty overnight.

Street parking is not permitted by the Kern Pavilion. Observe the "No Parking" signs and park in designated parking areas only. All fire lanes will be strictly enforced.



PLEASE HELP KEEP THE GROUNDS & BUILDINGS CLEAN

Show attendees are responsible for cleaning up after the animals in their care. "Poop Stations" with plastic bags and trash cans will be located in the designated dog walking areas and will be patrolled on a regular basis. In the grooming building, there will be "Clean Up Stations" with brooms and dustpans, and everyone is encouraged to keep his/her area free of accumulated dog hair and other trash to maintain the building in a clean and orderly fashion. Everyone's cooperation in taking good care of the show site will be greatly appreciated.
