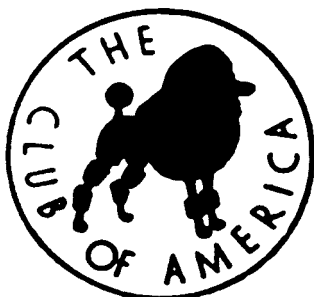

IMPORTANT - TRANSFER of dogs from regular classes to Best of Breed/Variety Competition (Ch. 11 Section 6, AKC Rules) MUST be made to the Superintendent/Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at this show. TRANSFERS by Junior Handlers from Novice to Open Class MUST be made to the Superintendent/Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show. SUBSTITUTIONS of Junior Showmanship dogs must be made at least one half hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship classes at the show. MOVE UP OF DOGS IN OBEDIENCE/RALLY CLASSES (Ch. 1 Section 16 of Obedience Regulations) The request for a move up must be in writing and presented to the Superintendent/Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Move ups for Obedience may be approved, provided the next level class and judge are available and the class has not reached its limit.

GENERAL INFORMATION & SHOW RULES

There will be NO space for unentered dogs.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to scheduled time of judging. Consult Judging Program for time of judging.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is judged. The Show-giving Club and the Superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the event, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made. An Administrative Fee of \$2.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. **An Administrative Fee of \$2.00 will be charged or withheld from refunds for duplicate entries.**

All dogs present must be held on leash except when being judged or in the exercising ring.

Cash prizes will be paid to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging is concluded and the Superintendent's Office advised at once. The Superintendents and Show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the event is over.

Declination of Entries - The Poodle Club of America, Inc. may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or any other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Poodle Club of America, Inc. or any official thereof.

As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

NO PRACTICING ALLOWED IN RINGS AT ANY TIME.

ANY INFRACTION OF HOTEL RULES WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE EXPULSION FROM THE HOTEL.

OBEDIENCE AND RALLY EXHIBITORS may enter the Civic Center through the front door marked "*Obedience Entrance*" starting at 7:00 A.M., Tuesday, April 26th.

EXERCISE PENS are allowed **only** outdoors in designated area and outside exercise pen mats may be required. The number of pens per exhibitor will be limited. Please bring adequate cover for pens. **No exercise pens are permitted in the building.** Limited public exercise pens are available Tuesday-Friday. **Exercising off-lead is grounds for expulsion from these events.**

OBSTRUCTION OF DESIGNATED FIRE CORRIDORS AND/OR FIRE EXITS IS PROHIBITED. DOGS MAY NOT BE CRATED OR GROOMED IN ANY AREAS ADJACENT TO FOOD PREPARATION OR FOOD SERVICE FACILITIES. EXHIBITORS MUST OBSERVE ALL "NO CRATING ALLOWED" NOTICES.

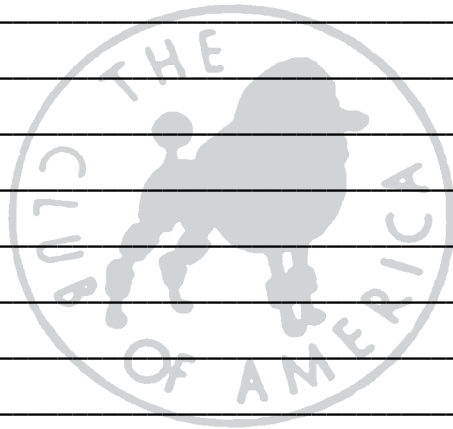
