FROM LEGACY EVENTS CENTER: Head north on 1100 West toward W 100 N/W Clark Lane (.8 mile). Continue onto UT-225 E (.3 mile). Turn left at US-89 Alt N (.7 mile). Take the 1st right onto Shepard Lane. Destination will be on the left.

FROM LAYTON HOTELS: Go north to Antelope Island Drive. Get on I-15 southbound. Take Exit 328 toward Kaysville (.3 mile). Turn left at 200 North (.6 mile). Turn right at N Main Street (3.3 miles). Turn right on Shepard Lane. Destination will be on the left.

RV PARKING RULES:

- All RV's must have a working fire extinguisher.
- No discharge of gray or black water or sanitary tanks on the grounds or in open containers.
- All parking is at your own risk. The SCA, the Specialty Committee, Davis County Legacy Events Center, Davis County or the City of Farmington assume no responsibility or liability for damage or loss to any vehicle, their contents or dogs.
- Exhibitors are responsible for damage & clean-up of their own space. Any charges for damages or clean-up will be billed to the exhibitor occupying that space.
- All RV's will park in the space assigned to them by the RV Chair.
- There are no hookups allowed in the stall barns.
- Sites are gravel, no trees. Bring mats & your own shade.
- RV check-in can be made as late as 9:00 pm on the day of the show, if stall has been reserved & paid in full. After 9:00 pm, reserved RV stalls will be left unlocked for late arrivals. Everyone must wait for their assigned space prior to permanent parking. We will park everybody in their assigned slots, regardless of arrival time.
- We do not guarantee any availability or access for RV's to the Events Center without a reservation & full payment.
- Please keep the RV area clean & neat. Throw away all garbage.
- Failure to check out on time will result in late charges as well as the possibility of being towed at your own expense. Check out time is 12:00 pm, unless otherwise noted by management or the event.
- No parking on the lawn or in the roadways. If there is not enough room to park in your site, you may use the parking lot on the northeast side of the grounds.
- All pets must be leashed & under physical control of the owner/handler at all times. Be sure to pick up the poop, as it is not up to other guests or the ground crew to clean up after your pet. If you need bags to pick up waste, we keep plenty in the office & in the pet mailbox located near the dog walk areas.
- Please respect privacy of fellow guests. Do NOT walk through occupied sites.
- Be sure to close awnings when leaving your rig unattended. Strong winds can come about suddenly & cause severe damage.
- Cleanliness of the park is important to us. Sites are to be kept clean & orderly, as determined by management. Please leave restrooms as you would like to find them. If they are in need of attention please notify someone in the office.
