### Hotel/Show Site Information and Rules

- A non-refundable cleaning deposit is required for all rooms containing dogs. Exhibitors shall be responsible for any damage done by their dogs to the hotel and/or show site or any individual or animal at the hotel or show site. Dogs may not be kept in rooms which are registered as "dogless".
- Dogs must be crated when left alone in hotel rooms. NO EXCEPTIONS! All dog crates in rooms must be kept on heavy duty plastic. Dogs must be kept quiet in the rooms. You will be given ONE verbal warning. A second offense will result in the cancellation of your hotel room. Room towels are not to be used to groom/bathe dogs and/or for cleanup of dog waste. The hotel has ZERO tolerance for urination or defecation inside the hotel. Any damage fees will be assessed by the hotel and fined directly to the individual responsible. Anyone that takes dogs into areas of the hotel marked "No Dogs" will be in violation of the Specialty Rules.
- The Radisson Inn offers large, grassy dog walk areas and grassy edging around the walkways. To make the best use of all grass, private x-pens will be restricted. NO private x-pens will be allowed on grass! You will need to bring a mat for under the x-pen or tarp and chips. There is plenty of room to bicycle or run your dog.
- Any soil deposits made by dogs MUST be cleaned up immediately. Bags and trash receptacles will be distributed around the "Dog Walking Areas" for the deposit of this soil. You will be responsible for cleaning up after your dog. Failure to do this is a violation of the Specialty Rules. Any liquid or soil deposits made by the dog on the interior areas of the hotel MUST be cleaned up immediately and sprayed with disinfectant which is provided in each hallway and in the Show Room. Failure to adequately clean up after your dog will be in violation of the Specialty Rules.
- This will be a smoke-free show site. Smoking will not be permitted in the Show Room or crate areas.
- All conformation, obedience and rally events will take place indoors in the climate controlled ballrooms of the convention center adjacent to the hotel itself.
- The Show Site will be available to exhibitors Monday, September 19, 2011 in the afternoon.
- Crating will be allowed in designated areas only. Because of space limitations, you may be asked to stack your crates and no X-pens will be allowed in the crate area. The Show Committee reserves the right to limit the number of crates per handler. No saving or roping off crating space. All passageways must be kept open; crates are not allowed in walkways. Aisles will be marked for easy access. Owners or agents will be responsible for keeping the area surrounding their crates clean. The crate area will be policed daily by members of the Show Committee. Owners or agents are responsible for excessive barking while dogs are crated. All dogs must be removed from crate room one-half (1/2) hour after conclusion of judging.
- No dogs allowed in public REST ROOMS or HOSPITALITY ROOMS.
- No cell phones or flash camera use allowed in show room dogs during show hours. No baby strollers in show room.
- Only approved vendors may sell merchandise on the show site grounds in areas designated for vending. Anyone selling merchandise that has not been approved by the show chairman or selling in a non-designated area will be in violation of the Show Site Rules.
- There will be no space for unentered dogs in the Show Room or crating area.
- Photographer will take photos on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Any individual or individuals who violate the Show Site Rules as spelled out above, and/or commit any other actions which may be considered "prejudicial to the sport of purebred dogs" will be dealt with in accordance with the American Kennel Club rules and will be summoned to an Event Committee Hearing and the appropriate disciplinary actions will be taken on behalf of the CSPCA against such individuals's privileges. Good show sites are extremely hard to find and we as a club need to take care of them to ensure that we will be welcomed back. These Show Site Rules will be enforced by the CSPCA, Inc.

#### ROUTES TO THE SHOW & HOTEL

##### DIRECTIONS

**From Harrisburg International Airport and Lancaster** - Travel I-283 West (toward Harrisburg) to I-83 South to Exit 41A (Camp Hill - Route 581 West). Then take Exit 5A (Camp Hill - Route 15 North). Follow Route 15 North for approximately 2 miles and the Radisson is on the left.

**From Philadelphia Area** - Travel I-76 West (PA Turnpike) to Exit 236 (Gettysburg). Go North on Route 15 for approximately 6 miles, the Radisson is on the left.

**From Pittsburgh Area** - Travel I-76 East (PA Turnpike) to Exit 236 (Gettysburg). Go North on Route 15 for approximately 6 miles, the Radisson is on the left.

**From New York City** - From the George Washington Bridge, the Holland or Lincoln Tunnels, follow the New Jersey Turnpike South to Exit 14 (I-78 West). Then take I-81 South and get off at Exit 65 (Enola/Marysville). Travel Routes 11/15 South for approximately 5 miles. At the 5th traffic light, turn right onto Walnut Street. Continue straight through two more traffic lights and the Radisson is on the right.

**From Upstate New York, Northeastern Pennsylvania and Canada** - From the Pennsylvania border, travel I-81 South and take at Exit 65 (Enola/Marysville). Travel Routes 11/15 South for approximately 5 miles. At the 5th traffic light, turn right onto Walnut Street. Continue straight through two more traffic lights and the Radisson is on the right.

**From Allentown and Bethlehem** - From the Pennsylvania border, travel I-83 North to Exit 41A (Camp Hill - Route 581 West) then take Exit 5 (Camp Hill - Route 15 North). Follow Route 15 North for approximately 2 miles and the Radisson is on the right.

**From York, Baltimore and Washington D.C.** - From the Pennsylvania border, travel I-83 North to Exit 41A (Camp Hill - Route 581 West) then take Exit 5A (Camp Hill - Route 15 North). Follow Route 15 North for approximately 2 miles and the Radisson is on the right.

**From State College** - Travel Route 322 to Route 11/15 South. At the 5th traffic light, turn right onto Walnut Street. Go straight for two more traffic lights and the Radisson is on the right.

**From Hershey** - Travel Route 322 West to I-83 South. Take Exit 41A (Camp Hill - Route 581 West). Then take Exit 5A (Camp Hill - Route 15 North). Follow Route 15 North for approximately 2 miles and the Radisson is on the left.

Everyone should update the maps or GPS Devices. There has been a major reconstruction of the intersection of US 11, US 15 and PA 581, about 2 miles south of the show site. Some ramps have been closed and new ones built.

The Speed Limit on US 11/15 just south of the show site is 35 mph. There is a community pool and hospital in the vicinity so that the limit is heavily enforced.

#### EXHIBITORS RESPONSIBILITIES

**INTRODUCTION:** To insure the future use of facilities for dog shows, it is the goal of the Chinese Shar Pei Club of America, Inc. to maintain a show environment that is clean, safe and in keeping with the AKC Rules and Regulations, as well as, any Hotel regulations and expectations.

#### WASTE CLEAN UP

- Exercise dogs in designated areas only.
- Keep dogs away from entrances, planters, etc.
- Be prepared to clean up after dogs at all time.
- CONSEQUENCES - Anyone observed not cleaning up after their dogs will be brought before the Board of Directors.

#### HOTEL

- All exhibitors are required to abide by the regulations and expectations set forth by the AKC and the Host Hotel.
- Any exhibitor found in violation of the regulations and expectations of the AKC and the Host Hotel will be asked to check out immediately and will be subject to appropriate discipline.
- All crates in the crating room must be marked with the owners name, cell phone number and hotel room number. Crates without this information will be removed.
- All rooms with dogs must leave a valid credit card at the desk when they check in and expect it to be run for charges to date midweek and then for the balance at the end of their stay. The guests cell phone number or that of someone on site must be left at the front desk in the event a problem arises and needs immediate attention.
- The CPSCA has contracted a four dog limit per room. If there are any rooms that have more than four dogs they will be charged at the rate of \$25.00 per day per extra dog. This arrangement has been made with the Hotel Management.
- Anyone who removes furniture from their room without permission from the Hotel management will be charged \$300.00 to cover storage, damage and liability. This arrangement has been made with the Hotel Management.

Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or in harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip or left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety as this is considered mistreatment.

★ NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS ★

**CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.**

**DOGS MAY ARRIVE** any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **DOGS NOT REQUIRED** for further judging will be excused.

**JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS.** Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the Show Superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**ALL DOGS PRESENT** must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

**CLASS CASH PRIZES** will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the show Superintendent to be advised at once. The Show Superintendent and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

**THERE SHALL BE NO** drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises. **EXHIBITORS SHOULD FOLLOW THEIR VETERINARIAN'S RECOMMENDATION** to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

**ISCA RESERVES** the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. **ALL TROPHIES AND PRIZES** must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed or otherwise distributed.

**THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD OR AN ATTENDEE'S CHILD** is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor or attendee. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors and attendees will exercise control and restraint over their children on the days of the show.

**ALL PERSONS ATTENDING THESE DOG SHOWS** hereby waive any claim for damages against the The Chinese Shari-Pei Club of America, Inc. its members or agents, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.
