DRIVING DIRECTIONS

FROM THE EAST (Hickory, Winston-Salem, Greensboro, etc.): Travel West on I-40, Take exit 53-B onto I-240 West towards downtown Asheville, As you cross the "French Broad River Bridge" merge into the far right lane, marked as an "Exit Only" for Exit 3-B (labeled Westgate and Resort Dr), Merge into the right lane as you pass the Westgate Shopping Center, Crown Plaza driveway is IMMEDIATELY as you round the curve to your right.

FROM THE WEST (Knoxville) Travel East on I-40, Follow signs for I-240 East towards Asheville (left exit), Merge into the left lane and take exit 3A, This will merge you onto Patton Ave., At the 2nd light make a right onto Regent Park Blvd (between Denny's and Pizza Hut), The road will bear right and our entrance will be immediately on the left (before entering Sam's Club parking lot), Follow the road past the golf course to the main entrance

FROM THE NORTH (Johnson City, TN): Travel South on Hwy 19/23 (also known as I-26 East) Merge onto I-240 West, Stay in the right lane as you merge, marked as an "Exit Only" for Exit 3-B (labeled Westgate and Resort Dr), Merge into the right lane as you pass the Westgate Shopping Center, Crowne Plaza driveway is IMMEDIATELY as you round the curve to your right.

FROM THE SOUTH (Asheville Regional Airport, Greenville/Spartanburg) Travel West on I-26, Follow signs for I-240 to Asheville, Merge into the left lane and take exit 3 This will merge you onto Patton Ave. At the 2nd light make a right onto Regent Park Blvd (between Denny's and Pizza Hut) The road will bear right and our entrance will be immediately on the left (before entering Sam's Club parking lot) Follow the road past the golf course to the main entrance.

!! ATTENTION EXHIBITORS !!

All dogs must wear belly bands or britches when on the floor of the hotel lobby, in the hallways, or in the meeting rooms.

Multiple failures to comply will indicate the need for a bench committee hearing.

Grooming will be conducted in the designated grooming areas *only*. Please clean up after yourself and your dog(s).

All crates must be stacked in the grooming areas.

No crates, grooming tables, or ringside tables will be permitted in the Expo Center during judging, except for grooming tables in the reserved ringside grooming area and in the actual grooming area. **Dog strollers (but not for grooming)** will be permitted in the Expo Center.

Exercise Pens will be permitted outside only, and in designated areas only, and **MUST** be tagged with owner's name and contact telephone number. Exercise areas will be clearly marked and **ENFORCED**. PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG.

Dogs entered at these events MUST have rabies and shot records available.

All trophies not claimed on each day of the shows become the property of The Havanese Club of America, Inc. None will be mailed.

No dogs permitted in public restrooms.

An Event Committee Hearing will result from a violation of Hotel Rules or any damage to Hotel/Motel rooms, grounds or premises. A Bench Committee Hearing will also result in any behavior that is deemed detrimental to the breed or to AKC.

The Hotel requires that dogs be crated in room when owner is not present, and that if you have dogs that persistently bark in the Hotel room, you may be asked to leave the Hotel.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
